

GALLAECIANS AND ROMANS: THE EVOLVTION OF A SHARED HISTORY

More than 2000 years ago, this history was forged in land and time. What your eyes will see over the next four days are merely vague recollections of what really happened, as many of the events of the past have been lost in the mists of time, and the persons responsible for building the future are oblivious to them. This is not the case of this history, which will be relived here.

The Gallaecia that was once occupied by the history and life of an empire was previously inhabited by a large number of peoples. Each had a very different understanding of how the world should be: some favoured violence and warfare, whilst others focused their efforts on cultivating life in all its forms. Societies that were built on the foundations of the struggle to seize the riches of others, yet governing them all was the force of nature and their gratitude to the gods. Nobody was more aware of the value of rituals and the need to celebrate the events of the past, as tradition has and always will be the basis of all forms of existence.

Yet life as they knew it was to change very swiftly. The people that lived in the mountains were the first to spot an advancing army of men clad in iron.

Those that managed to escape could recall the blood flowing along the rivers in the tracks and the fire in their eyes. In the face of this peril, the peoples of these lands held a large assembly on the banks of the River Miño to decide their fate. Whilst some called for peace and servitude, others cried out for war and the survival of their race. No decision had been made when they were surprised by a storm of dust and ash appearing in the distance, accompanied by a thundering noise. The message was clear: Rome had arrived, and with it a sense of dread and uncertainty.

On one side of the river, several legions under the command of Caicus Antistius Vetus, legate of the Emperor Octavius Avgustus. And on the other, the dwellers of these wild lands, armed and ready to defend their home to the death. The Roman attack did not come immediately; this was not their way of making war. The tradition of Roman justice was governed by laws that were always upheld, but which the Gallaecians unwittingly broke. The decision to make war was therefore a legitimate one. The Romans had come to stay, but it would be the gods that would have the final word.

The memories of the river lost the day before was a rude awakening for the hillfort dwellers. Confident that they had defeated the enemy, they discovered that they had merely suffered a setback. The sun nestled among the rocks, indicating that the longest day of the year had arrived. It was a time of transition: the end of one cycle and the beginning of another. Yet despite the circumstances, the various tribes were determined to celebrate the rituals that were propitious of such a day. The rage and bloodshed fuelled a fire whose flames reached far higher than any of the trees that grew in this place. The sparks served to regroup all the tribes, whose cries eventually fanned the flames of war, leading them to put aside old rivalries in favour of the future vows that were made, until the unimaginable occurred. A group of Romans entered to disrupt to the ceremony and defile the sacred place, something that the gods could not tolerate. The fight was ruthless on both sides. The Gallaecians emerged victorious, but their triumph was short-lived, as among the losses was the daughter of the newly chosen leader of the Gallaecians. Although she did not lose her life, she was abducted during the battle. Hatred and fear ruled in equal measure that night. Those that survived swore that no Roman would occupy their hillforts unless they were buried underground.

The moons that followed were long and harsh. Neither side succeeded in subduing the other, and consequently the fierce fighting led to what everyone expected: the final battle. Pavlus Fabius Maximus led the Roman troops. The iron burnt the hands of the fighters with such intensity that it broke the

spears and shields. Numerous lives were avenged, but many of those that fought there would never live to see another day. After a long and fierce fight, the battle ceased on the orders of Pavlus Fabius Maximus. The Romans acknowledged the resistance of the brave Gallaecian race and tried to negotiate a truce. The encounter was long and riddled with obstacles. The Romans brought with them a written promise of peace that would respect the native peoples' way of life in return for their submission to their authority and the payment of taxes. Sense and the gods were reasons enough to put an end to the carnage, as their inferiority lay in their means, not their bravery. And so it was that the Gallaecians were resigned to their fate.

This pact was set in stone with the construction of a monolith to commemorate the events. As a show of their undertaking to the territory and its inhabitants, the Romans promised to compensate them by founding a city on this sacred site. The city they built, whose two thousand-year history we can still admire today, was named Lvcvs Avgsti, in honour of the Roman Emperor Octavius Avgustus, and possibly the god Lvgo as well.

Just as Lvgo would never have existed without Avgustus and the Gallaecians, if it were not for the dedication of the 19 associations and your presence and participation, Arde Lvcvs would have no reason for being. Welcome to this opportunity to (re)discover Lvgo, the most historic of Galician cities.
